3) Requests for dispensations:

There were no requests for dispensation.

4) To receive a report from the County and District Councillor:

County and District Cllr. S. Burroughes said that the new Green bin rollout was going very well especially as Suffolk Coastal District Council was now charging residents for recycling. He said that the Council were also looking at setting up glass recycling as this cannot be dealt with at household level. County and District Cllr. S. Burroughes noted the new logo for East Suffolk District Council which he said represented different parts of the District. He said that the new Beccles Southern Relief road has opened and that he was trying to get new housing developments to be in keeping with Suffolk's existing housing and environment. It was noted that a meeting had been arranged at 2pm on November 13th 2018 with Flagship Housing and in answer to a question as to contributing to the new defibrillator, he would look at it but he was contributing heavily to creating disabled parking spaces at the Walpole Pavilion.
